Notes:

1. Applies only to Board-maintained watercourses.

2. This rate is reviewed periodically, with the indicated rate being applicable for the period from 1 April 2009 – 30 June 2009 only.

All the above charges and fees include VAT at the standard rate of 15% except Surface Water Development Contributions which are exempt from the payment of VAT. Where an application fee is due, but is not paid when the application is submitted, payment must be made in full before the application will be considered. The only exception to this is the payment of Surface Water Development Contributions, further details about which are given on the relevant application form.

The Board also passes on its costs for preparing legal agreements relating to granted consents, including any legal fees incurred. A charge may also be levied for the provision of flood risk information, depending on the type and amount of information requested.
