King's Lynn Drainage Board ('the Board') gives notice that it proposes to carry out works to replace Church Farm Pumping Station, south of Gaywood River, near King's Lynn. The proposals include works to an existing access track, demolition of the present pumping station and discharge pipes, and construction of a new pumping station (maximum design capacity 0.50m³/s) and associated outfall into Gaywood River. The works are being undertaken to increase the capacity of the pumping station and reduce flood risk. It is intended to commence works in June 2012.

With reference to the above statutory instrument it should be noted that it is not proposed to carry out an environmental assessment in relation to these works.
