

POSITION: CO-OPTION OF TWO BOARD MEMBERS

The Board has a total of 23 members, 11 of which are elected by occupiers of agricultural land who pay Drainage Rates directly to the Board for the services they receive (the elected members), and 12 members are appointed by the constituent Councils to represent the extent of other interests in the Drainage District (the appointed members).

A rare opportunity now exists for two individuals with appropriate knowledge and experience of Surface Water Drainage and Flood and Coastal Erosion Risk Management to join East Suffolk IDB as co-opted Board members to fill two vacancies in the elected membership. These appointments would be until 31 October 2024 at which point you will need to stand for election, if you would like to continue as a Board member for a further three-year period.

The Board meets at least three times a year either virtually or within the IDB area and you will be expected to attend these meetings, generally held in January, June and November. Meetings usually take place in the morning and last approximately two hours. You will be expected to have read the meeting papers in advance of the meetings and actively contribute to the decision-making process at Board meetings. This represents a time commitment of about half a day every four months.
