East Suffolk Internal Drainage Board ('the Board') gives notice that it proposes to carry out works at Reydon Pumping Station (OS Grid Ref: TM 484 764), as follows:

Installation of additional submersible pump, connected to disused discharge pipeline, with electric controls in new control cabinet plus associated civil engineering works as required.

The works are being undertaken to improve the flood risk management service provided in the area and are scheduled to take place during winter 2012 – 13.

With reference to the above Statutory Instrument it should be noted that the Board considers that the improvement works are not likely to have significant effects upon the environment and does not intend to prepare an environmental statement in respect of them.
