LAND DRAINAGE, ENGLAND.

The River Nene Catchment Board (Reconstitution of the Hundred of Wisbech Internal Drainage Board) Order, 1952

Made - - - - 25th February, 1952

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Section 4 (3) of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, and of every other power enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the River Nene Catchment Board (Reconstitution of the Hundred of Wisbech Internal Drainage Board) Order, 1952

2. The Scheme in relation to the Hundred of Wisbech Internal Drainage Board submitted to him by the River Nene Catchment Board under Section 4 (1) (b) of the said Act, a copy of which Scheme is annexed hereto, is hereby confirmed.

4. The expenses of the Minister in connection with the making and confirmation of this Order shall be borne by the Catchment Board and shall be part of the administrative expenses of the Catchment Board.

LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930

RIVER NENE CATCHMENT BOARD

Hundred of Wisbech Internal Drainage Board

The River Nene Catchment Board (hereinafter called "the Catchment Board") in pursuance of Sub-section 1 (b) of Section 4 of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, have prepared the following Scheme making provision for certain matters in the said Sub-section, viz. :—

- (1) The reconstitution of the Hundred of Wisbech Internal Drainage Board ;
- (2) Certain other matters supplemental thereto or consequential thereon.

And the Catchment Board submit the Scheme to the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries (hereinafter called "the Minister") for confirmation under Section 4 of the Act.

SCHEME

As from the date on which an Order of the Minister confirming this Scheme becomes final and has effect :—

- (1) The Drainage Board of the Hundred of Wisbech Internal Drainage District as constituted by the River Nene Catchment Board (Hundred of Wisbech Internal Drainage District) Order, 1950(a), confirmed 25th September, 1950, by the Minister under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, shall be reconstituted and shall consist of fourteen members who, with the exception of the first members, shall be elected in accordance with the provisions of Section 33 of and the Third Schedule to the Land Drainage Act, 1930. The first members of the said Internal Drainage Board as reconstituted shall be appointed by the Minister and shall hold office until the First day of November in the calendar year next following the calendar year in which the Order of the Minister confirming this scheme becomes final and has effect ;
- (2) The existing rights, powers, duties, liabilities, obligations and property (including deeds, maps, books, papers and other documents) of the Hundred of Wisbech Internal Drainage Board as constituted by the River Nene Catchment Board (Hundred of Wisbech Internal Drainage District) Order, 1950, shall be the rights, powers, duties, liabilities, obligations and property of the Internal Drainage Board as reconstituted by this Scheme.

The Common Seal of the River Nene Catchment Board was hereunto affixed this 22nd day of October, 1951. } (L.S.)
