
The Islington Catchment Flood Risk Management Scheme is being undertaken by King's Lynn Drainage Board, with consultants Royal HaskoningDHV and contractors Balfour Beatty.

The Project

A changing climate and the age of the existing Islington Pumping Station means replacement is required to ensure future flood risk is minimised.

The design for the new pumping station has evolved over the last year. Once built, the new Islington Pumping Station will provide better protection to approximately 1,500 homes and 500 businesses.

The project is now moving into the Design and Build phase and enabling works have already commenced. Construction is due to begin later this year.
