MARINE AND COASTAL ACCESS ACT 2009 APPLICATION FOR Islington Flood Risk Management Scheme (FRMS)

Notice is hereby given that the King's Lynn Internal Drainage Board Kettlewell House, Austin Fields Industrial Estate, King's Lynn, Norfolk, PE30 1PH has applied to the Marine Management Organisation under the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009, Part 4, for a marine licence to undertake construction of a New Pumping Station with associated discharge pipework and outfall structure, decommissioning of the existing Islington Pumping Station including removal of redundant equipment and hazardous materials, and making safe any equipment to be left in situ and refurbishment works at the Straight Mile and Eau Brink outfalls. Plans showing the position of the works may be inspected at WMA, Kettlewell House, Austin Fields Ind Est, King's Lynn, Norfolk PE30 1PH.
