Kings Lynn Internal Drainage Board Order 2013

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 3(5) and (7) of the Land Drainage Act 1991, has now made an Order confirming a Scheme submitted by the Environment Agency under section 3(1) of the Act.

The scheme makes provision for:

- (i) the reconstitution of the Kings Lynn Internal Drainage Board so that the number of members elected in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of and Schedule 1 to, the 1991 Act is altered from 15 members to 10 members;
- (ii) matters supplemental thereto or consequential thereon;

The Order will become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament unless during the period of thirty days after the date of publication of this Notice, a memorial is presented to the Secretary of State by some person or body affected and having an interest sufficient for the presentation of a memorial (as prescribed in Article 6 of the Land Drainage (River Authorities) General Regulations 1965 (S.I. 1965/443)) praying that the Order shall be subject to special parliamentary procedure.

A copy of the Order, together with a copy of the Scheme has been deposited at the offices of the Environment Agency, Anglian Region, Kingfisher House, Goldhay Way, Orton Goldhay, Peterborough PE2 5ZR, and at Bromholme Lane, Brampton, Huntingdon, PE28 4NE, and at the offices of the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, Area 3C, Noble House, 17 Smith Square, London SW1P 3JR for public inspection during normal office working hours for a period of thirty days after the date of publication of this Notice.
