- Commenting on planning applications within (or near to) each Board's District, to promote sustainable drainage techniques and ensure the WMA regulatory requirements are clear.

As a Senior Sustainable Development Officer the successful candidate will play a leading role the team's proactive engagement with new development / planned changes within the WMA catchments via planning consultations and applications for Land Drainage Consents, working **predominantly within the South Holland IDB Drainage District.**
